

Classroom Temperature Notes

Since *warm air rises*, the upper air in the room will be the warmest. Other places in the room that also may be **warmer** will be areas exposed to direct sunlight, particularly during the warm seasons. Darker coloured surfaces in direct sunlight and the areas around the heat vents may also be warmer.

The **coolest areas** will be next to windows during the winter, especially those that face north or west and areas next to exits or doors where drafts occur.
